Directors please review the roles and responsibilities of you and your potential CDA candidate.

1. Candidates are required to come to class on time. Directors should make sure that their candidates have enough time to get to class.
2. In order to implement what they are learning, they have to be working directly with children.
3. It may be necessary for the CDA candidates to make changes in their classroom environment. It is expected that the Director will support any changes that need to be made.
4. CCCC is requesting the Director's permission for CCCC staff to observe the CDA candidates using a Pre then Post Infant and Toddler Environment Rating Scale, Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale or Family Day Care Environment Rating Scale.
5. Directors will help their CDA candidate in choosing an appropriate advisor.
6. Some candidates will be chosen to receive three technical assistance sessions. Director needs to agree to the candidate being observed and receive technical assistance on site.
