

## **Become a Registered Family Child Care Provider**

Are you interested in starting your own family child care business?

CCCC of Union County is the state's sponsoring organization for Family Child Registration for Union County. Our staff trains, inspects, monitors and registers Family Child Care homes for compliance with state regulations.

You must be 18 years of age and in good mental and physical health to apply to become a registered provider in the state of New Jersey.

The benefits of FCC registration are: being placed on our database to receive referrals for child care, free training, an opportunity to join the Child and Adult Care Food Program so you can be reimbursed for the meals that you serve to the children in your care and technical assistance resources to improve the quality of care that your offer. As a registered FCC Provider, you are eligible to accept children who are receiving assistance from the state to help parents to pay for the child care that they need if the parent meets the state eligibility requirements.

Registration helps parents recognize you as a professional caregiver who has met state requirements.

## The Family Child Care registered providers are not employees of Community Coordinated Child Care. The providers are independent owners of their small business.
